

Editor's Corner by Michael J Posner

Its now 2019 and an almost new to me 2016 M4 has brought a bit a mod fever. So far I have stuck with the cosmetics, carbon fiber shift knob, front euro license plate, lug nut covers (why does BMW insist on ugly lug bolts!) and some coding with Carly. I also modded an old snap adapter meant for smaller iPhones to work with my 120ghb iPod. Next will be an integrated radar detector and laser jammer system to prevent those pesky speeding ticket. Worked well in my 2013...

I also will probably reinstall my compact subwoofer and amp custom made to fit under the cramped trunk of the M6 and a perfect fit in my M4. Just have to find the time to get this mounted.

Performance tuning is also an option, though it can effect the factory warranty. I am considering the open flash tablet, (tinyurl.com/yckmct5t), which allows for a variety of stages to be installed, from mild to hard core. It also backs up the original ecu settings to allow the car to be stock when in for warranty service. The tablet plugs into the OBD II port of the M4, and can also read and clear diagnostic codes. Price is only \$499. Carbahn, Steve Dinan's new firm, also offers a similar solution (tinyurl.com/ya3o5zar), but its priced a bit higher at \$850. I am watching reviews and will make a decision shortly. Stay tuned, as they say.

MYBMW EXPERIENCES—Daniel Kane BMWCCA #012660

I first became aware of BMW's in the early 70's when I lived in East Norwich NY (Oyster Bay).

My next door neighbor had, a 2002 1970 (?)...

In early 74 I owned my first BMW 2002, it was a 73 Tii that I bought from Competition and Sports Cars in Greenwich CT. I do not remember what I paid for it, but it was "bargain priced" because it had about 45,000 miles on it, and at $1\frac{1}{2}$ years old, the dealer did not want to "retail" sell it.

I had that car for about four years as a daily driver, using it to drive to Long Island City where I worked.

I had the car repainted, added a 5 speed transmission, a front spoiler, changed the wheels and tires, added

an ANSA exhaust; finally selling it at about 160,000 miles.



I joined the BMWCCA around 1975 and got involved in the Club. We had regular Club meetings at various restaurants on Long Island, in Queens and Westchester, and back then there would be twenty or thirty 2002's in the parking lot with their hoods up. The Club was all about cart enthusiasts and the cars back then talking about mods and performance.

I also bought a used '72 Bavaria from Competi-

tion in '75 for my wife to replace her Pontiac Station Wagon.

I had it at work one day and someone made me an offer I could not refuse, so I sold it. Needless to say my wife was a bit perturbed, but, that was followed by a beautiful '73 3.0S, so happy wife (happy life –ed.). Then that got sold, another Bavaria followed, then a 2800CS, an E21 320, a 630, and a few Mercedes Sedans.

As you can see cars have been a "sickness" for a long time, and I have owned over sixty since my first, a 1935 Chevy my dad bought for me in 1950, when we were both 15 years old.

A group of us somehow wound up as club officers and I took on the job, along with another member, as Coeditors of the Club magazine, *DIE ZUGSPITZE*. We put a lot of time and effort into the magazine and even won a national award as best publication.

Staff meetings were held at my house about once a month, and we set up rallies, events and obtaining speakers from tire companies, and equipment suppliers for our monthly meetings.

In the early 80's I met a guy who had imported a "grey market" Mercedes Benz 350 SL. After a short discussion I decided to go to Germany and buy a 911. While I was there I discovered the 323's (E21). These were cars that BMW, NA never imported into the USA, but were very popular with German performance people as they had the small six cylinder engines, four headlights and four-wheel disc brakes. This was a BMW hot rod compared to our four cylinder slugs. I bought one, shipped it home, had that car federalized and took it to one of

the BMW club meetings where it got sold that night.

So now another few trips to Germany for a few (actually more than a few) more 323i's.. a few 911's also, all while supposedly working a regular job as an architect and getting sick for a week at a time.

Which brings me, retired, to Florida where I am on my third 5 Series Touring (unfortunately



no longer imported since 2010). I also have had a few 3 series, a 535is, an L6, sold to another club member...and so it continues. I miss having a manual transmission car so the hunt for a late model E30 convertible has started. I am also a 30 year PCA member.
