They were able to secure the venue – The Miami Dade-College North Campus and provide lots of support for me and our fantastic volunteers. My First BMW by Jon van Woerden

My Dad was an executive with BMC (Yes the British Motor Corporation) and after spending years with MGs I had a vacation drive in 1972 with my aunt in Switzerland in her new 2002Tii through the Alps and I fell in love with her new BMW.

I had an MGC GT and a 74 VW Scirocco S and a few years later I went to check out an BMW M1 (which obviously I could not afford) but the place had brand new ('82) Gray Market E21 323i so off I went, sold the MGC and the Scirocco and the bimmer was mine.

In 1985 I participated in the Florida chapter's Floridafest a precursor to Oktoberfest 86. It was Yale Rachlin who was my HPDE instructor at Sebring and then I went on to win the Autocross. A year later the car was involved in a small bumper crash and I asked my insurance agent if I could return the car to its Euro bumpers, which were replaced (in Europe) with the US ones when I bought the car. Saving bit of money compared to replacing the bumper shocks, it was a yes.

I faithfully drove the 323i until I had needed some engine repairs in '96, but had just spent most of my money on new cameras and lenses, so I asked my neighbor, a local banker ,if she could find me a cheap ride for a few years. She replied that she would and next thing I know she says she found a BMW I might like (something with a letter and number, though she could not remember what it was). She said she could get it cheap and I probably would not have a payment for a few months, so into our studio comes a '88 Cinnabar Red M6 with 42k miles. I took the new ride and parked the 323i in the garage. I believe it is time to pull her out do the repairs and bring my 23 year barn (well garage) find to the 50th O'fest this year. My first and well now my 7th BMW.
