My Fírst BMW by Ríck Gílbert

If anyone has followed my 2013 M6 saga, I can now report that after 15 days at Braman, and 35 new seals and gaskets she is ready to roll. I then sought an extended warranty but was told by Easycare and Auto-Pom that they would not warrant an M6. USAA was my first choice (backed by Assurant) but they have cancelled the service (a call revealed it is being retooled).

With the warranty expired (a good six year run), and worries about future repairs, I traded her in on a one owner, clean Carfax, 2016 M4 convertible. My new to me M4 is Metallic White over full Sakhir Orange. No competition package, but otherwise a well optioned car with full leather, adaptive suspension, blind spot monitoring and the Executive

Package. She has 26k miles and a good 14 months left on the factory warranty. Like my M6, I will extend that for another two or three years



through BMW (top tip, if you can buy out of state you can save about \$250 plus some states do not charge sales tax on warranties).

I was debating whether to pay the \$700 to transfer the maintenance plan. Car shows no service needs, but that is easily reset and I plan on

an immediate oil change. I spoke with my Braman Service Rep and he said the 30k spark plug change was \$1,700. With that plus a 30k brake fluid service and an oil change, the \$700 transfer fee on the maintenance was a no brainer.

I will do some mods in the future, upgrading the stereo, some carbon fiber trim (already did the shift knob) and a small carbon fiber spoiler.
