## Edítor's Corner by Michael J Posner

In order to address my oil consumption issues in my 2013 M6, I reached out to Roundel's Mike Miller, Redline, Blackstone and others. The consensus was that I should move to a thicker oil. BMW specs 0w-30 or 5w-30 for the M6, a very light weight oil. This is a change from oilder M engines that used 10w-60 weight oil. So based on these discussions, I decided to switch to a 5w-40 Liqui Moly Synthetic Oil, which is slightly thik-der at high temperature. The theory is that the thicker oil could reduce consumption (which is currently at two quarts every 1300 miles). I also had the existing oil tested but the test, shown below, only revealed one issue, excess silicone, which is most likely attributable to the silicone used to replace one of my valve cover gaskets last January. I will monitor consumption and after 5,000 miles, have the oil changed and retested. Stay tuned.
