Editor's Take by Michael J Posner

The optimism that the Covid 🐺 pandemic was almost over when we produced last quarter's FLasher has given rise to the Delta Variant and continued issues regarding Covid. Despite the issues, the Club continues to try and engage the BMW community by holding both indoor and outdoor events. We encourage you to safely participate by attending one of our meetings or our cars and coffee events. I was greatly encouraged by the turnout at the Braman cars and coffee event in September and I hope we will have more events like that in all of our counties.

My issues continue with my 2001 E39 M5. I was able to replace the



missing key as well as the deteriorated rear window gasket with parts from Braman. Do not forget to ask for your BMW CCA membership discount. You will need your club card or membership number.

I also had had the wheels refinished at RimFX and after about a month the front wheel started crazing. I took the car back and they refinished them at no charge and also fixed my hazy headlights.



My only remaining issue is a vibration at 50 miles an hour. I have replaced the thrust joints, had the wheels fixed and installed new front tires. I also know that the previous owner had replaced the driveline and the guibo (flex joint). There are few remaining culprits including motor mounts, other bearings, or even possibly the brakes. If a solution is found I will report that in the next issue.

As many of you know, I also am the proud owner of a 1965 Chevrolet Corvair Corsa. If you are interested in older air cooled cars I encourage you to come out to our South Florida Corvair Club charity car show, the seventh Annual Aircooled for Charity event. All unique cars are welcome to participate, including cars that rely on H_2O (though I do note that dihydrogen monoxide is the leading cause of drowning, accelerating corrosion creating rust and the main ingredient in acid rain). All monies raised from the event is donated to our designated charity 100+ Abandoned Dogs of Everglades.




